## Fabric matters

**April** – Energy saving Lightbulbs replaced near nave alter to provide better lighting during services and reduce costs

**May** – Mower maintenance carried out and a new battery purchased thanks to Gareth James for this.

**June** – Tyre and innertube repaired by me. Mower continues to keep in good repair for future grass cutting

July – ascension chapel roof cleared of soil and debris

**August** - Fire extinguisher maintenance and repair/replacement. Bell tower clock winder repaired and updated. Wooden couplings replaced for more substantial metal ones.

**September** – gas meter changed to digital meter.

Valley gulley in sacristy roof cleared of soil and trees! Wall in sacristy now drying out. This will need to be monitored and repaired when fully dry.

October – Smart meter installed for vestry hall electricity Parish hall kitchen window replacement after damage

## November –

**December -** Boiler maintenance carried out and Gas safety certificate received.

Jan 2022 – Renewed appropriate streaming licences for service to be broadcast on YouTube

**February** – Roof repair from storm damage – covered by insurance Tree removed from grounds due to fungus

**March** – fly tipped rubbish from around the church removed and cleared

**April** - Roof above Lady chapel repaired thank you for donations received
