Deanery Synod 2020

Our Deanery Synod representatives from St Michael & All Angels' were Eleanor Relle and Jessica O'Sullivan at the beginning of 2020. Fr Neil attends Deanery Synods as the Vicar of St Michael & All Angels'. Elizabeth Bryson attends Deanery Synod because she is our representative on the M&M (Ministry and Mission) Group in the Deanery. Jessica resigned from the Deanery Synod at the end of August when she resigned from being Churchwarden. At our APCM in October 2020 Elizabeth was voted as our Parish Representative on the Deanery Synod and is now a voting member.

The Deanery Synod met on 25th February 2020 at St Martin's Church. It was announced that Eleanor Relle has been elected until August 2021 to serve on the Diocesan Synod, thus filling the Casual Vacancy.

The main focus of the February Meeting was *"Back to the Future"*. Rev Chris introduced how we all face change and how we as a church respond to that change. We were told that Bishop Rose said "we cannot be effective in mission if our hearts are not singing". How do we cope with 21st century society? Everything must be underpinned with prayer. Rev Chris & Diane led the Postcard Game with feedback from parishes as to how they would like their church to look in 10 years' time. Peter Ingrams and Lyndall Bywater lead us in prayer and informed us about the Diocese Network Prayer initiatives.
